#### Youth Class Policies- PLEASE Read!

#### **Youth Class Tuition:**

Continuous classes from Sept.16<sup>th</sup> to end of May. Every class is a 2-hour reserved class. Tuition is **\$175.00** for every 4 class by check or cash, payable to Zoll Studio. Materials for classes are covered in the tuition payment. The balance for all classes is due on the first day of class. Checks are submitted for deposit at the end of each month.

# **Make Up Classes:**

There are **NO MAKE-UP classes** offered to students. When a seat is reserved for 4 consecutive classes, we cannot offer that seat to another student. **A courtesy once/semester missed class at no charge will be offered.** So, the once/semester missed class is skipped over. Billing begins again the following week. Any additional missed classes during that semester will be charged. If an additional missed class occurs **between payment cycles**, you will be charged since it is expected that a student is attending continuously for at least the semester.

## Continuous Classes:

Once a student enrolls, it is assumed that they will remain for at least a semester and usually for the entire school year. A payment is sent every 4th class, payable to Zoll Studio. Please let the instructor know if there is a change.

## **Trimesters:**

September through December

January through end of May

June through mid August (missed classes treated differently due to summer vacations)

## Refunds:

After the payment is received as a deposit or a final payment, the student is expected to attend. **There are no refunds.** 

#### Class Size:

Class sizes are small, usually between 7-10 students, so each student can receive tailored individual instruction multiple times during the class. If classes are over 10 students, instructors will provide trained assistants to make sure the ratio of teacher to student is around 10:1.

#### **Illnesses:**

Zoll Studio policy for illness is **fever and symptom free for the previous 24 hours.** When in doubt please wear a mask so as to not infect others in the classroom. If your child is sick and misses a class, there are no refunds or make-ups unless that date happens to be the once/semester courtesy missed class. (See above)

# **Property and Dismissal:**

Zoll Studio, LLC, does not accept responsibility for loss, damage or theft of anyone's personal property. Instructors leave the building within 5-10 minutes from the end of class. Please do not be late for pick up. Thanks.

# **Handicapped Access:**

The back door entrance to the studio is handicap accessible. If the door is locked, call the studio, 410-296-0233, and someone will open the door.

#### **Photos:**

From time to time, photographs of artwork or groups of students working on art projects are taken to promote the studio and to advertise. Any students in the photo are not identified. No compensation is provided to individuals that happen to be photographed.

# **Weather Policy:**

Zoll Studio loosely follows BCPS (Baltimore County Public Schools) winter weather related closings. If BCPS opens late then Zoll Studio will open on time. If BCPS closes early then the studio MIGHT close early. Please watch for an email, text or phone call from your instructor if the weather doesn't seem to be really bad. Sometimes an individual instructor will determine the status of a later afternoon or evening class. IF BCPS is closed, Zoll Studio will most likely be also closed. When in doubt, watch for an email, text or phone call message from the instructor.

#### Annual Zoll Studio Art Show:

All students are encouraged to display some of their better artwork in the Zoll Studio art show, held each year during the weekend prior to Thanksgiving. It is a large art show of youth, adult and instructor work with over 600 guest attending during the weekend event. An email will go out to parents about 6 weeks before the show, requesting that artwork be readied and dropped off for the studio for hanging. The students truly enjoy seeing their artwork displayed in an official art show, so please add this event to your calendar. This year's show will be November 21, 22, and 23, 2025.
